ANNUAL ASSOCIATION MEETING

The Cedarwood Association's annual meeting was held on April 12, 2000 and conducted by President Sandy Kiesling. Special guests included Edward Adelman, Associate Vice President for Operations - Brandeis University and Joe Giordano, Waltham Ward 7 City Councilor.

Mr. Adelman reported on the two Brandeis construction projects for expansion of the Rose Art Museum and the demolition of the Ford Building. (See article on Brandeis project on next page). Neighbor Jeanette McCarthy commented that abutters to the property should receive an official notice.

Councilor Joe Giordano spoke on a variety of topics: traffic planning, the new elementary school, and the Regis College sewer project.

- Joe is arranging a public meeting with the City Traffic Planner to discuss traffic in our neighborhood in general. Neighbor Bill Morley, is petitioning the city to extend the Rockridge Rd/Villa St. island to reduce speeding. If you would like to sign Bill's petition call him at 894-3376.
- Regarding the new South Street elementary school, Joe stated that plans are moving ahead and it will be located at the site of Mulberry Day Care Center.
- On the Regis College sewer project, Joe reported that new sewer pipes will be installed on Weston St. between the Cedarwood Ave. bus stop and Vernon St. The city's engineering department confirmed that the new pipes can handle both the current volume and the anticipated volume from Regis.

Joe plans to walk through the neighborhood to meet residents and hopes to continue the tradition of publishing a newsletter for Ward 7 constituents.



Rose Museum Addition at Brandeis

Through the generosity of Harold Foster, a \$3.5 million addition is being planned for the Rose Art Museum. The Rose Art Museum houses one of the finest collections of twentieth-century art in New England.

Space constraints presently make it impossible for more than a small fraction of the Rose's collection to be displayed at any one time. Further, the existing galleries lack adequate space to exhibit sculpture and other three-dimensional work. The proposed addition essentially will consist of a large single gallery connected to the rear of the original building. The floor levels of the existing building and rock ledge dictate the placement and elevation of the addition.

Due to the proximity of the existing building to the property line, a zoning variance will be necessary to construct the addition. To indicate the position of the addition, its corners have been staked in the field (wooden stakes with pink ribbons).
