Cedarwood Association Annual Meeting Thursday April 27 at 7pm

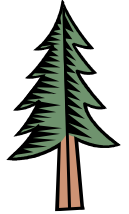
Woodside's Garage 2nd floor: across from the Cedarwood entrance on Weston Street
