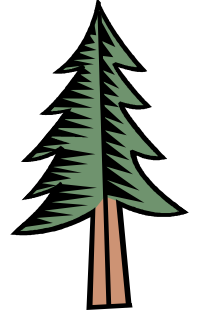

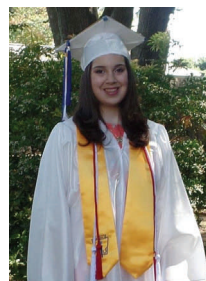


Cedarwood Annual Picnic

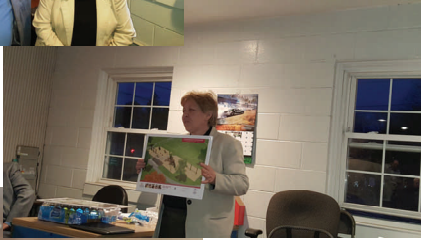
Event Wrap Ups:
