

PUBLIC SAFETY NOTES

As you are aware from our last newsletter, the Association petitioned the traffic commission for the erection of stop signs as all intersections in Cedarwood. The result is two stop signs at the intersection of Harland and Florence Road, one at the intersection of Florence and Cedarwood Avenue, one at Thornton Road east and Cedarwood Avenue and one at Florence Road and Virginia Road. In addition, yield signs were installed at the intersections of Villa Street and Cedarwood Avenue and Virginia Road west and Cedarwood Avenue. Please drive slowly and safely in our neighborhood. You can report any any automobile that is driving unsafely to the Waltham Police. Cars which are illegally parked in the neighborhood or driven in an unsafe manner and can be positively identified as being operated by Brandeis students should be reported to Shelly Kaplan (742-4410) or Ed Callahan or Joe MacDonald (742-4240).
